- Highline's 2019 CCSSE Executive Summary of Results informed the creation of the Effective Teaching Course.
- Goals of the Effective Teaching Course:
 - 1. Create a community of learners and create more inclusive and equitable practices in classes and in interactions with students.
 - 2. Learn about the equity gaps that Highline students face.
 - 3. Implement more equitable practices in their classrooms.
 - 4. Examine how to use Highline's college-wide tenure criteria as instructors.
